That the Joint-Standing Committee on Roads & Bridges be and they hereby are authorized to purchase the balance of the lot of gravel at the lower end of Pearl Street, containing about 3000 squares, at a price not to exceed \$4.75 per square, on the condition that the owners of the same will give the City 3 years to remove it, ~~the same~~.

The expense of the same to be charged to the Appropriation for Streets and Paving.
