- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that the Federal Department of Transportation has recommended within the FY84-85 budget that Transportation Systems Center (TSC) be de-federalized, allowing the building to be purchased by private enterprise; and
- WHEREAS: This City Council, although concerned about the constant need to expand the tax base, is equally concerned over the possible loss of over five hundred jobs at this site; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council communicate with both Secretary of Transportation Elizabeth Dole and Speaker of the United States Congress Thomas P. O'Neill, Jr., urging them to take whatever steps which are necessary to reverse this rash decision.
