To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of a grant for \$62,800.00 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity to the Grant Fund Human Rights Commission Salary and Wages Account (\$29,800.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$15,000.00) and Travel and Training Account (\$18,000.00). The Human Rights Commission must use these funds for the Fair Housing Assistance Program. Required activities include participation in mandatory HUD-sponsored training, case processing, education and outreach, implementation of data and informative systems and other Fair Housing Activities. The appropriation covers a third of the full-time investigator's salary, and will cover a part-time legal intern and/or a full-time summer intern.
