The Cease fire in Vietnam has resulted in troop withdrawals by the United States and the release of the "POWS" in a pre-arranged time table

WHEREAS:

When the prisoner of war time table was completed the reports of the torture and inhumane treatment of the prisoners was made known to the public

WHEREAS:

This was in complete violation of the rules of the Geneva Convention

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record as being unalterably opposed to the sending of any reconstruction funds to North Vietnam

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That certified copies of the vote of this City Council be sent directly to President Richard Nixon, the speaker of the House and the Majority Leader of the Senate and to the Secretary of Defense, Eliot Richardson.
