WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that by quick action of two employees of the Recreation Department a life was saved, and

WHEREAS: James Judd, Motor Equipment Operator for the Recreation Department since 1970 and George Brazil, Gardener-Laborer for the Recreation Department since 1975, having heard faint cries from the pond by the 6th hole of the Fresh Pond Golf Course went to that location and discovered a man drowning, and

WHEREAS: These men jumped in and pulled the man out, called the Police and Fire Rescue, all of which prevented a fatality, and

WHEREAS: Police Officers Robert Klodner and Robert Mahoney were the first two officers on the scene and began administering first aid in order to assist the victim's breathing, now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our congratulations to James Judd and George Brazil and to Officers Robert Klodner and Robert Mahoney for their quick and life-saving action, and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward suitably engrossed copies of this resolution to the individuals involved as well as to their respective department heads so that this recognition by the City Council will be made a part of their personnel file.
