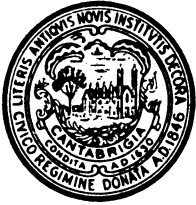

Attached please find for your review and action an order requesting the acceptance and appropriation of a grant in the amount of \$31,291 from the Cambridge Housing Authority to the Department of Human Service Programs Grant Fund.
