- 1.-Nov. 28, 1911, Order that the Mayor be requested to place drivers of patrol wagons under the provisions of the 8 hour law.
 - 2.-Nov. 28, 1911, Order amending Section 6 of the police regulations by striking out so much as relates to weekly drills.
 - 3.-Nov. 28, 1911, Common Council order amending Section One of the police regulations by increasing the number of reserve officers to 22
- Also, a resolve from the Common Council of July 17, 1911, that the drivers of the patrol wagons should be placed on the basis of 8 hours per day,
