COUNCILLOR PREUSSER

- WHEREAS: One of the outstanding attractions of our city is the flavor and historical significance of its buildings; and
- WHEREAS: These buildings are a resource which we must protect to preserve the special quality of life that we have in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Our Historical Commission recently received a National Award for its publication: "Survey of Architectural History in Cambridge"; and
- WHEREAS: In spite of this, the past year has shown that architecturally priceless buildings can be demolished without proper review; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to prepare a procedure which would be used to enforce the City Council's policy of insisting that no building which was constructed prior to 1939 could be demolished without the prior written consent of the Cambridge Historical Commission.
