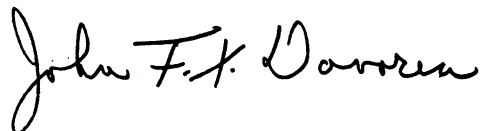

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

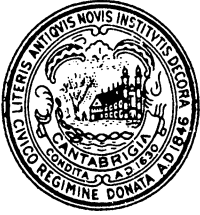
To advocate, develop, administer, or assist programs to serve the educational needs of the members of minority groups in business management, marketing and sales, by (a) establishing training programs, (b) training participating businessmen, (c) working with other agencies of a similar nature, and (d) creating opportunities for members of minority groups.

To furnish education and provide for the dissemination of information to small business organizations on a non-profit basis, of a public service nature, including, but not limited to the above.

To carry on any educational or charitable function permitted by the Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 180.

To receive monies or any other form of assistance from any branch of government, municipal, state, or federal; or from a corporation, trust, community chest, fund or foundation, or other non-profit organization; or from persons or enterprises; such monies to be used to implement the corporate programs.

And in general to help improve the quality of life among minorities within the exclusively charitable and educational meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Act of 1954.

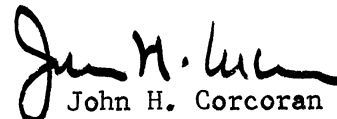
