IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETY (1997)

AN ACT TO DESIGNATE AREA CODES WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
and by the authority of the same, as follows.*

SECTION 1.

Effective August 1st 1997 all existing area codes within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts shall remain permanently in effect as they were on August 1, 1997 except for all cellular phones, pagers, fax machines, and modems each of which shall be assigned a separate and new area code with a minimum of three months notification.
