- WHEREAS: The rising cost of the operation of the Cambridge Hospital is related to the need to hire expensive, temporary workers, especially nurses and technicians, fields in which the country faces major shortages; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge needs to find cost-effective ways of attracting workers in these fields to Cambridge Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: The availability of convenient child-care might well attract personnel; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is requested to give serious consideration to the establishment of a day-care facility in or near the Cambridge Hospital to serve, especially, the needs of the Cambridge Hospital workers but to be made available, space permitting, to other City workers as well; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is requested to report back by the end of the year what progress is being made on this project.
