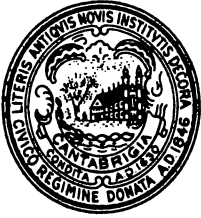
AN ORDER CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975



The attached appropriation request is necessitated by the fact that until recently the seven Parking Control Officers in the Traffic and Parking Department had been funded with CETA money. It is imperative that these seven Officers be maintained by the City as they are the persons responsible for enforcing the City's Parking Regulations, especially the Resident Parking Program. As a result of the work of these Officers approximately \$100,000 in revenue is deposited in the Parking Fund each month.
