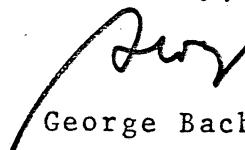
Dear Mr. President:

At the request of the Cambridge City Council, I am writing with respect to a piece of legislation that is currently before the Joint Committee on Rules. It is legislation authorizing the City of Cambridge to increase the licensing fee and renewal fee for automatic amusement devices.

The Council maintains that passage of this legislation is vital for two reasons: it will produce additional revenue for the City, and it will place much needed controls over where the devices will be located in the City.
