His Eminence Archbishop Iakovas, Chairman of the Board of Trustees at Hellanic College and a long time friend of the Maliotes family, officially dedicated the cultural center, and

WHEREAS:

The Maliotes family also constructed a high school in their native Greek village of Meleses, and

WHEREAS:

Charles Maliotes was born in 1895 in Greece and came to this country in 1917, later to serve in the United States Army in World War I, and

WHEREAS:

In 1945 Mr. Maliotes organized the Mediterranean Trading Corporation and only a year later founded the Lehigh Metal Products Corporation, now therefore be it

That this City Council congratulate Charles and Mary Maliotes for their tremendous financial and personal contributions to the Greek Community, and be it further
