- WHEREAS: It has been brought to the attention of this City Council that continuous and potentially hazardous odors are emanating from the property located at 10 Ware Street, owned by the New England Telephone Company; and
- WHEREAS: Several neighborhood residents have experienced difficulty sleeping and breathing while occupying their apartments, a problem so severe for one resident that she had to temporarily move to a neighbors apartment; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Health, Inspectional Services Department and any other appropriate individuals and/or departments to conduct a comprehensive investigation of this issue and to take whatever steps necessary to solve the problem as expeditiously as possible so that the residents of the neighborhood can once again enjoy their houses; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide this City Council with a report relative to the action taken pursuant to this order.

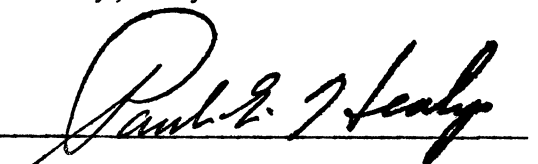
