Petition of the Boston and Maine Transportation Company, a corporation duly organized by law, proposed Transferor, and Englander Coach Lines, Inc., a corporation duly organized by law, proposed Transferee, petitioning the Department under Chapter 159A, Section 7A of the General Laws for authority to transfer from the Transferor to the Transferee certain certificates of public convenience and necessity as follows:


1. Certificate 247, D.P.U. 2489, as amended and restricted, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Greenfield, Shelburne, Buckland, Charlemont, Savoy, Florida, Clarksburg and North Adams.
2. Certificate 296, D.P.U. 2666, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Fitchburg, Westminster and Ashburnham.
3. Certificate 297, D.P.U. 2725 and 8699, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Gardner, Templeton, Phillipston, Athol, Orange, Erving, Montague and Greenfield.
4. Certificate 298, D.P.U. 2726, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Cambridge, Arlington, Lexington, Lincoln, Concord, Acton and Littleton, Ayer, Shirley, Lunenburg and Fitchburg.
5. Certificate 298-A, D.P.U. 2726, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Boston and Cambridge.
6. Certificate 310, D.P.U. 2770, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Ashburnham and Winchendon.
7. Certificate 465, D.P.U. 3847, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Winchendon and Templeton.
8. Certificate 554, D.P.U. 4034, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in North Adams and Williamstown.
9. Certificate 791, D.P.U. 4631, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Erving, Gill and Greenfield.

10. Certificate 964, D.P.U. 2726, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Cambridge.
11. Certificate 1277, D.P.U. 5239, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Fitchburg, Westminster and Gardner.
12. Certificate 1946, D.P.U. 8632, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire in Concord, Lincoln, Lexington, Arlington, Belmont, Cambridge and Boston.
13. To amend petition filed with Department on or about November 25, 1957, by adding following paragraph;

Certificate 1342, DP.U. 5239, authorizing the operation of motor vehicles for carriage of passengers for hire between Ayer and Fort Devens."

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Thursday, December 19, 1957 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.


