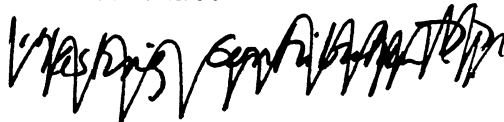
Whereas Cambridge Youth Hockey, a volunteer organization, has provided over 500 youths with an opportunity to Learn-to-Skate over the last three years, and,
