- WHEREAS:** Municipalities, such as Newton and Worcester have started composting programs;
- WHEREAS:** The State Legislature, in the Solid Waste Act of 1987 has allocated funds to support the effort of municipalities to develop composting programs, including "leaf and yard waste composting"; and
- WHEREAS:** The City Manager is recommending recycling legislation to the City Council; now therefore be it
- ORDERED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to investigate the feasibility of a composting program for Cambridge, the eligibility of such a program for State funds, and its potential cost-effectiveness and to report back to the City Council the results of his investigation.
