Valerie Burns is a member of the Cambridge Family Sea Cobras Swim Team. She is a "D" girl (9-10 year old age group) who has been swimming for the Sea Cobras since September and has had an excellent season. She made the time cut-offs in 5 individual events for the Eastern Massachusetts District Championships held at Medford High School on February 8, 1998. She swam in three individual events (the maximum number that one person is allowed to swim by YMCA Swimming Rules), a Medley Relay, and a Freestyle Relay. Valerie placed 8th in the 50 yard Freestyle with a time of :31.32, 9th in the 100 yard Freestyle with a time of 1:11.70, and 7th in the 50 yard Backstroke with a time of :38.71. With her season's best times in the 50 yard Freestyle (:31.32) and the 100 yard Freestyle (1:11.24), she qualified for the New England YMCA Championships on March 21, 1998 at Brown University in Providence, Rhode Island. Valerie will be the only swimmer representing the Cambridge Family YMCA Sea Cobras at the New England Championships. She has worked very hard throughout the season and has continued to practice after the regular swim team season had ended to train for these Championships. We wish her the best of luck.
