WHEREAS:

In spite of this policy, controversies still surface from time to time over a lack of understanding of this policy and the manner for neighborhood residents to voice their preference of materials, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager request the Commissioner of Public Works to utilize a simple written questionnaire to determine the preference of neighborhood residents for brick or cement sidewalks, and be it further

ORDERED:

That this questionnaire include the official DPW policy in its introduction, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the questionnaires be distributed to all residents at least ten working days before work is scheduled to begin.
