Provided that, before erecting the above named signs, the petitioners shall file with the City Clerk satisfactory bonds in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000) each, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said signs.

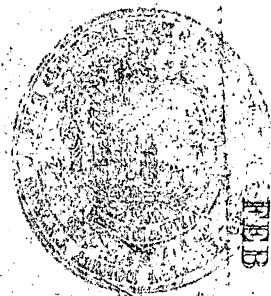

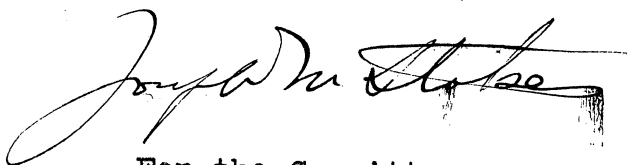
