Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to contract on behalf of this City, jointly with the City of Boston, for the widening of the draw of the Cambridge and Brookline bridge. That part of the expense which is to borne by this city, not to exceed the sum of Thirty-seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars, the same to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department, (Bridges: Rebuilding, Widening and Maintenance.)

The aforesaid contract to be made either with or without advertising for proposals therefor, at the option of the Committee.
