

City of Cambridge.

In the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty six.

An Ordinance  
Relating to the salary of the Mayor  
of the City of Cambridge.

Be it ordained by the City Council  
of the City of Cambridge as follows.

Sect. 1. There shall be paid to the  
Mayor of the City of Cambridge an  
annual salary of twelve hundred dollars  
in equal quarterly payments of three  
hundred dollars each, which shall  
be in full for services rendered in  
his official capacity.

Sect. 2. "An Ordinance  
establishing the salary of the Mayor  
of the City of Cambridge" passed  
March 20, 1850 is hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This Ordinance shall  
take effect from and after the first  
Monday in January, of the year eighteen  
hundred and fifty seven.
