ORDERED:-

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company to lay and maintain a sac terminal, with the wires and cables to be placed therein, upon the surface of the following public way or ways as requested in petition of said Company dated the 16th day of October 1970.

Oxford Street: (sidewalk area, easterly side) approximately one (1) foot from curbing, approximately 92' feet northerly from Wendell Street; one (1) serving area connector terminal; concrete base; L 22" W 22" depth 6" connector L 16" W 16" x 46" high, Bumpers (2) 4" x 5', 2½' above ground. Two concrete posts will be installed on both sides of the sac terminal comprised of the following dimensions, said concrete posts to be 4" in diameter, 5' in length, 2½" above the ground and 2½" below ground level on the curb side of the sac installation.


Substantially as shown on plan market-N.E.T&T. Co., No. 05-120 Dated 10-15-70 filed with said petition.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted said New England Telephone and Telegraph Company to lay and maintain underground conduits, manholes, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as it may desire for distributing purposes. The foregoing permission is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The sac terminal shall be of such material and construction and all work done in such manner as to be satisfactory to such municipal officers as may be appointed to the supervision of the work, and a plan showing the location of conduits constructed shall be filed with the City when the work is completed.
2. Said Company shall indemnify and save the City harmless against all damages, costs and expense whatsoever to which the City may be subjected in consequence of the acts or neglect of said Company, its agents or servants, or in any manner arising from the rights and privileges granted to it by the City.
3. In addition said Company shall, before a public way is disturbed for the laying of its wire or conduits, execute its bond in a penal sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) (reference being had to the bond already on file with said City) conditioned for the faithful performance of its duties under this permit.
4. Said Company shall comply with the requirements of existing ordinances and such as may hereafter be adopted governing the construction and maintenance of conduits and wires, so far as the same are not inconsistent with the laws of the Commonwealth.

ORDERED:

That permission be and hereby is granted the NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY to lay and maintain a sac terminal, with the wires and cables to be placed therein, upon the surface of the following public way or ways as requested in petition of said Company dated the 16th day of October 1970.

Oxford Street: (sidewalk area, easterly side) approximately one (1) foot from curbing, approximately 92' feet northerly from Wendell Street; one (1) serving area connector terminal; concrete base; L 22" W 22" depth 6" connector L 16" W 16" x 46" high; Bumpers (2) 4" x 5', 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' above ground.

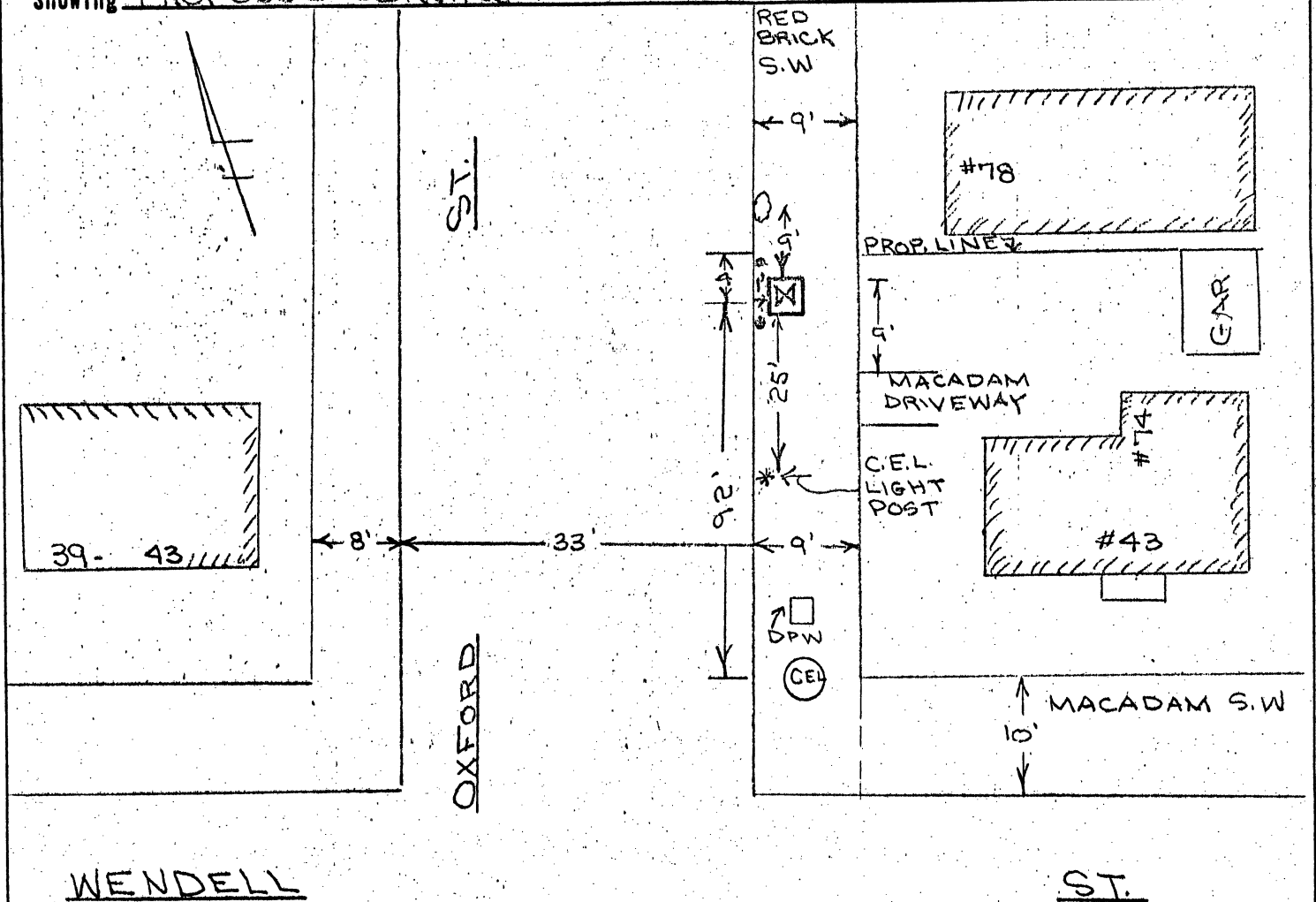

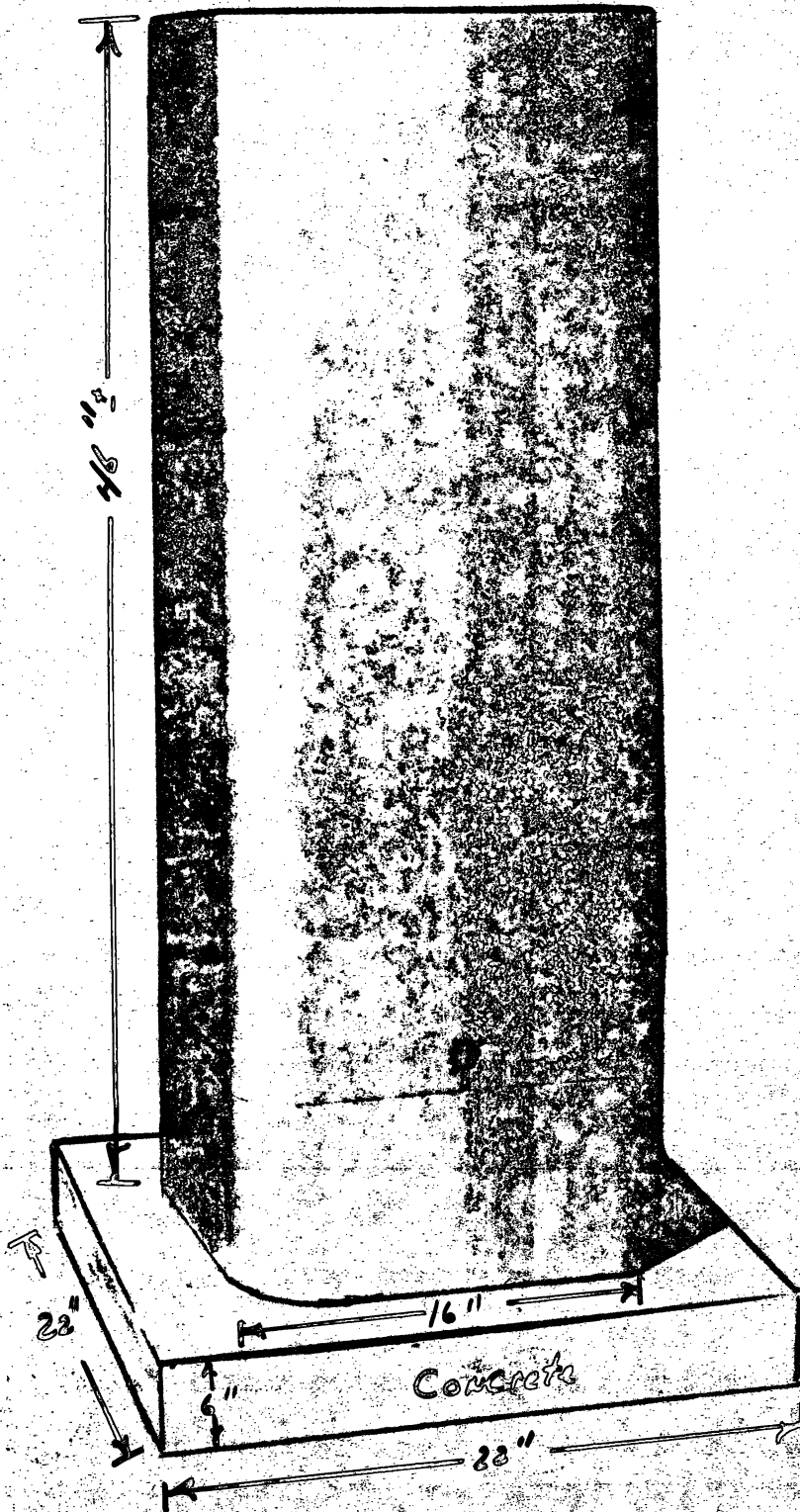

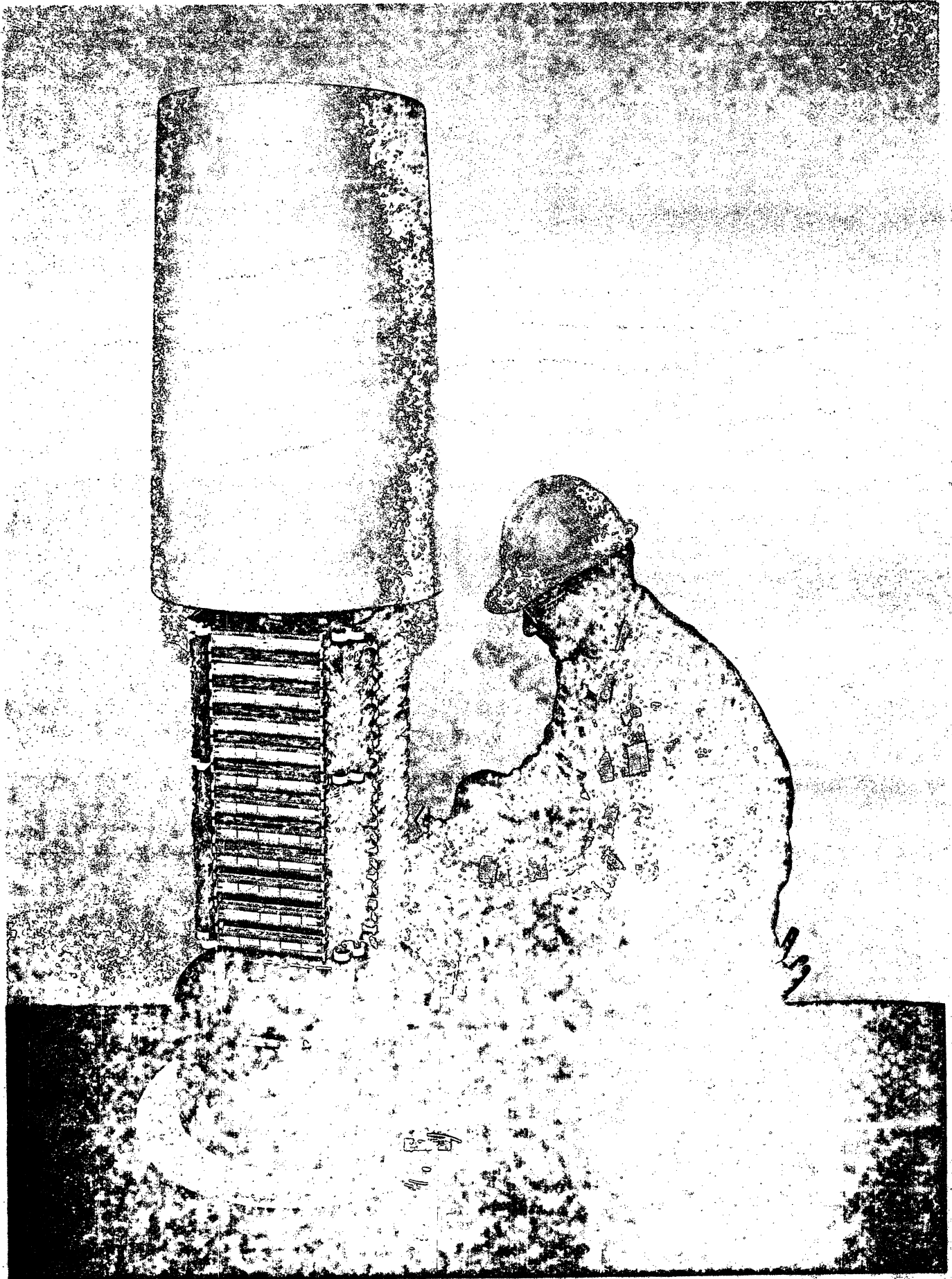
