

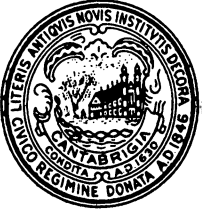



To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation of \$50,000 for the Fire Department's Extraordinary Expenditure Account is for the purchase of a new Rescue Truck. As you are aware, the State law has mandated certain changes in ambulance regulations. Under the new law, the City's Rescue Truck has had its certification as a rescue vehicle challenged. This appropriation, funded by Federal Anti-Recessionary money, will allow the City to purchase a modern Rescue vehicle that meets all State regulations.
