- WHEREAS: It was with profound sorrow that this City Council learned of the passing of James H. "Sonny" Foley on January 26, 1981 at the age of seventy-nine years; and
- WHEREAS: Sonny Foley was a sport legend in Cambridge from the year 1921 when he captained the Cambridge High and Latin Baseball team which won the Suburban League Championship and defeated championship teams representing Boston and Portland; and
- WHEREAS: His brilliant athletic career continued at Boston College where he excelled in hockey and baseball and was selected for membership in the Boston College Hall of Fame; and
- WHEREAS: Sonny Foley's career in athletics continued as a Hockey Referee, Hockey Coach at Rindge Tech, Baseball Coach at Cambridge Latin for thirty-two years where he produced outstanding teams and developed many talented players who earned new honors in college and professional competition; and
- WHEREAS: James H. "Sonny" Foley after his retirement as a Submaster in the Cambridge School System continued his interest in sports as a member of the Varsity Club and the Blue Chips Club of Boston College, the Gridiron Club and the Massachusetts Baseball Coaches Association and the Massachusetts Hockey Association; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: By the members of the City Council of Cambridge in meeting assembled on February 23, 1981 that we do hereby express our sorrow at the passing of James H. "Sonny" Foley, acknowledging the great contributions that he made to the athletic lore of the University City which he honored and loved, extend to his family and his friends, our most sincere condolences; and be it further
