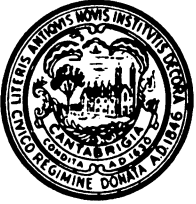

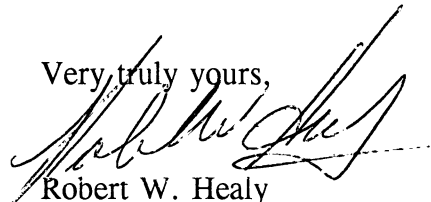

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$380,843.61 in the Grant Fund of the Cambridge Police Department to the Salary & Wages Account (\$195,740.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$135,303.61.00) and Travel and Training Account (\$49,800.00) from the Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety. The grant will fund the continued implementation of the City's Community Oriented Policing Program which includes the following elements: open lines of communication between the Department and the community; review and recommend changes to current policies and procedures impacting the Department's ability to improve services; review and recommend changes to enhance service with/through the utilization of technology; review and recommend changes to provide service in the most cost efficient manner possible the utilization of personnel, equipment and other resources; and review and recommend changes to improve the overall perception and image of the Department.
