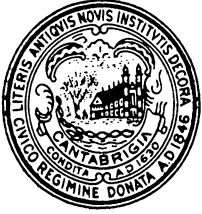

Under the Department's budget funds were allotted to pay salaries for two part-time Staff Assistants for staff support for the Transportation Forum. In discussing this with the Transportation Forum it was decided to continue the Consultant (John Hixon) on a full-time basis instead of using two part-time employees as it was felt it would provide greater efficiency and flexibility and provide more productivity.
