- WHEREAS: Development at Alewife, like other developments, is and will have a major impact on Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: A.D. Little plans for major expansion, the scope of which is still unknown; and
- WHEREAS: This expansion may require the purchase and/or manipulation of MDC wetlands that require protection and whose abandonment could have a major environmental impact; and
- WHEREAS: Such changes in land use would require environmental impact statements, approvals and legislation; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager prepare a full report of the proposed A.D. Little development and any proposed changes in land use for the City Council; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the M.D.C. and Cambridge State Legislators be informed that the City Council wants to have full knowledge of any plans, including those developed by the Metropolitan Planning Council, for land use in the Alewife area; and be it further
- ORDERED: No City approvals be given until the City Council has had an opportunity to hear all aspects of this matter.
