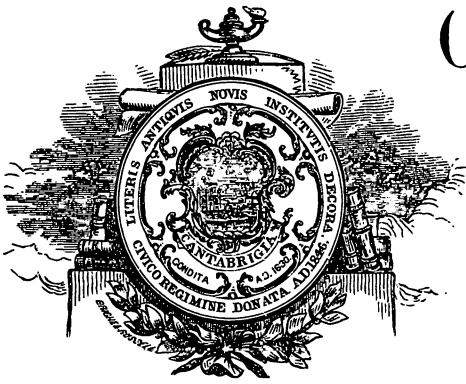

obstructions standing thereon*
