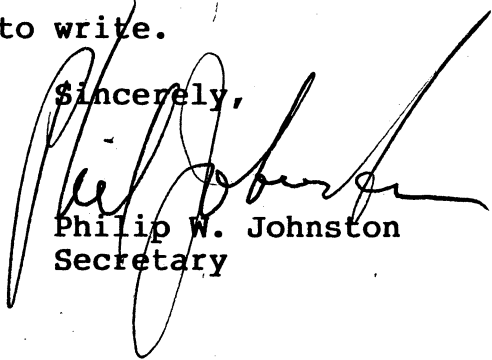
The Governor has asked me to respond to your letter and accompanying resolution in support of funding emergency homeless shelters.
