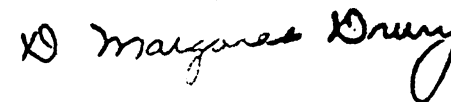

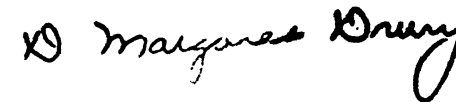

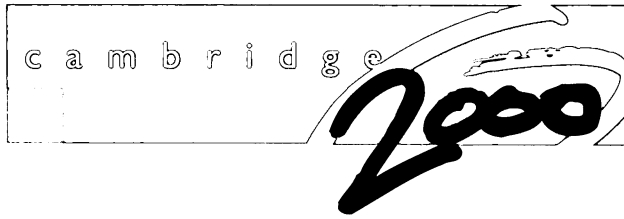

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$110,000 from the General Fund Finance Department MIS Salary & Wages Account to the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$75,000) and Travel & Training Account (\$35,000). The Management Information Systems (MIS) Department currently has four key vacancies. These vacancies which include the Director, Data Base Administrator, Web Master and Project Administrator, are reflective of a very competitive technology labor market. We are in various stages of recruiting for all four positions and hope to have a Director hired by mid-October with the other positions to follow.

The funds will be used to retain outside expertise to assist the MIS Department during the vacancy period and to increase training for existing departmental employees.
