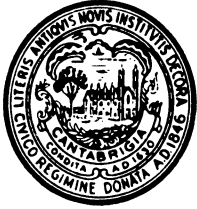

Subject Construction Procedure at 324-340 Franklin St.

As instructed, I visited the above captioned construction site with Ronald Bentubo, Senior Building Inspector and we observed the following:

- 1} No water being discharged onto the public way.
- 2} The area was clean and dry.
- 3} The construction superintendent was informed that he would be subject to criminal complaint if he did pump water into the city storm system without approval from Public Works.
- 4} A periodic inspection of this site will be conducted in order to insure that reasonable construction practices are being complied with.
