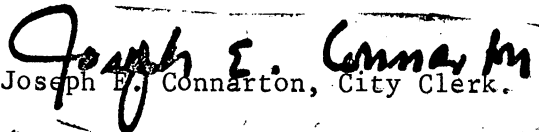
DECEMBER 12, 1988

- WHEREAS: The War Memorial Pool is an asset which is used by both the School Department and the Recreation Department jointly and serves the needs of a wide cross section of the City; and
- WHEREAS: There have been a number of serious complaints regarding the cleanliness of the locker room area and the area when parents can observe the activities of their children in particular and the whole building in general; and
- WHEREAS: Scheduling a time when the building can be thoroughly cleaned from top to bottom is difficult because of the high usage; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager direct the appropriate person in the School Department and in the Recreation Department to sit down together with the view in mind of coordinating a thorough cleaning sometime during the Christmas Break and arranging routine maintenance schedule which is mutually acceptable to both departments to keep the building as clean as possible so that this valuable facility will be maintenance in a safe healthy manner.
