CITY COUNCIL ORDER

Ordered that the City Manager is requested to confer with the director of Public Works to determine whether there is an alternative to stapling no parking signs on trees when street cleaning operations are underway. In view of the serious potential hazard created when the signs are pulled off leaving sharp ended staples sticking out of tress, sometimes at eye level, and in view also of the possible long-term expense to the City resulting from disease which may be introduced to tress as a result of repeated staplings over the years. Alternatives which it is requested be considered are tying the signs to trees, affixing them with elastics, and erecting them on temporary stakes rather than to trees.

A report is requested within 14 days.
