The status of the Springfield Street Parking Lot is that all tenants have moved out or been relocated and as soon as the weather allows, the demolition of the last building will be accomplished that would mean that the relocation and demolition phases would be complete making the final phase which is the construction of the parking lot possible.

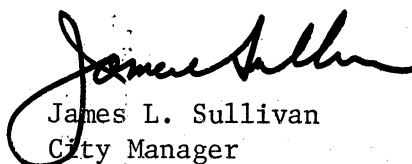
