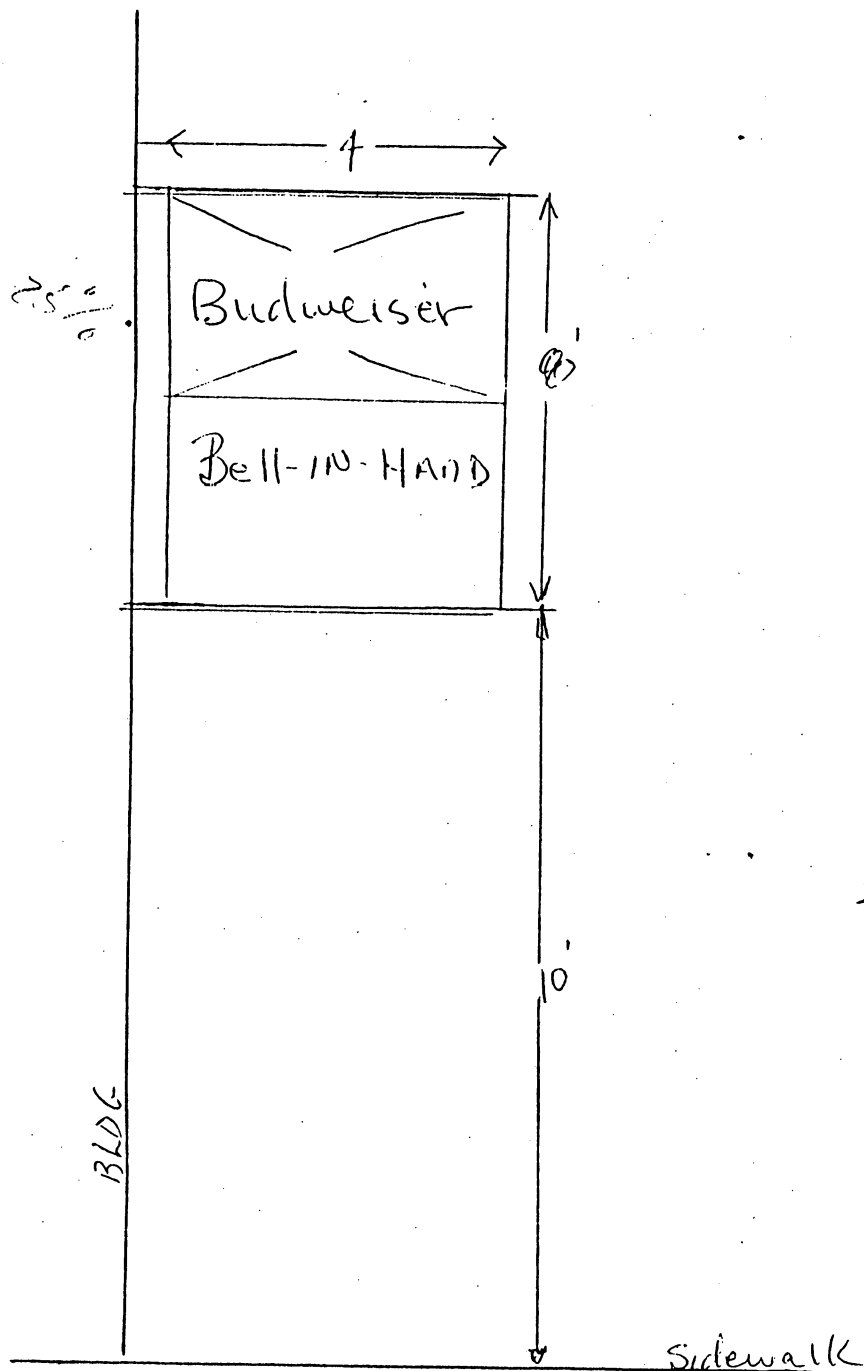

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Bell-in Hand Cafe for the erection of a sign at 2448 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge.

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

Subject to the condition that the sponsor's trade-mark occupy no more than 25% of the sign, which would conform with provisions of the new draft of the proposed sign ordinance.

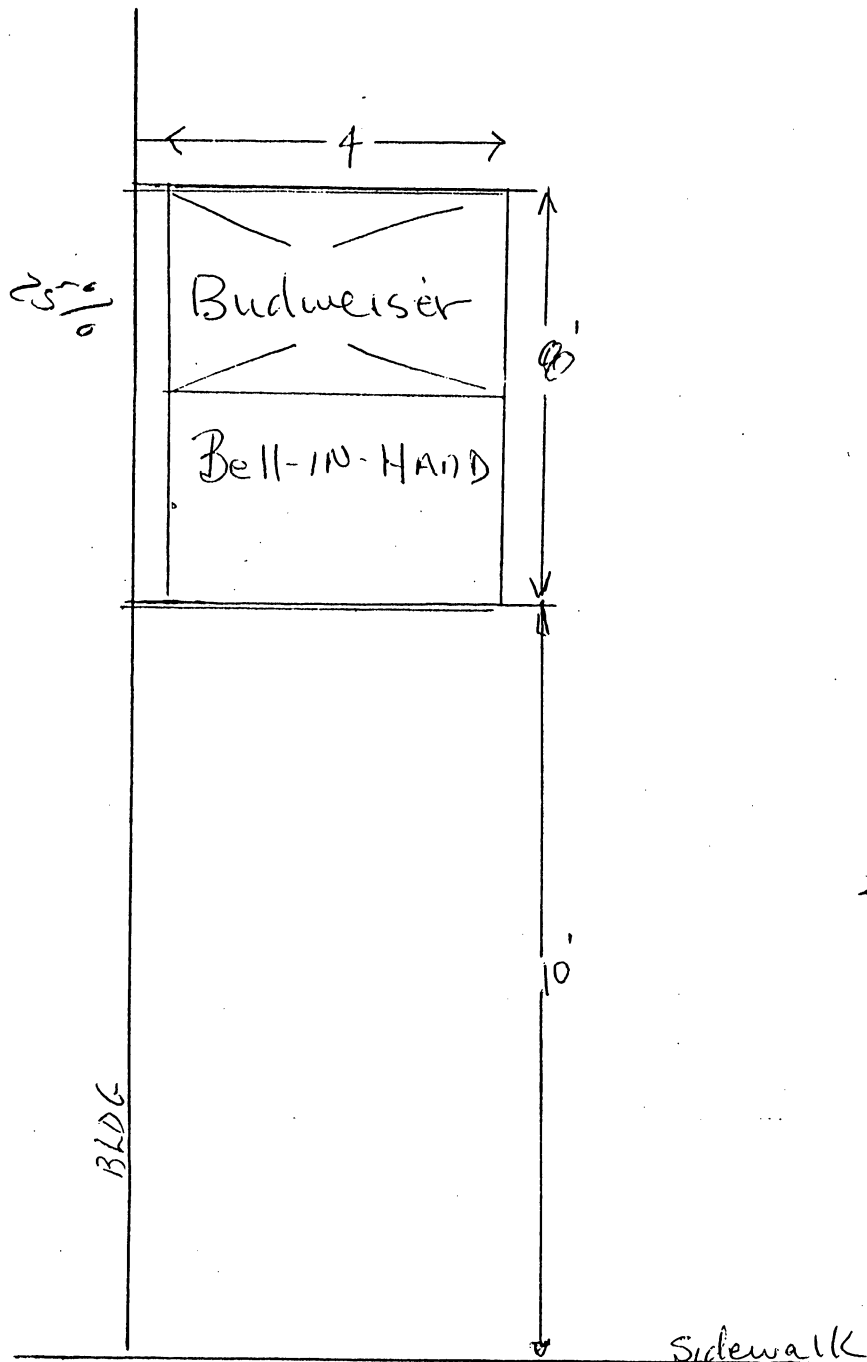

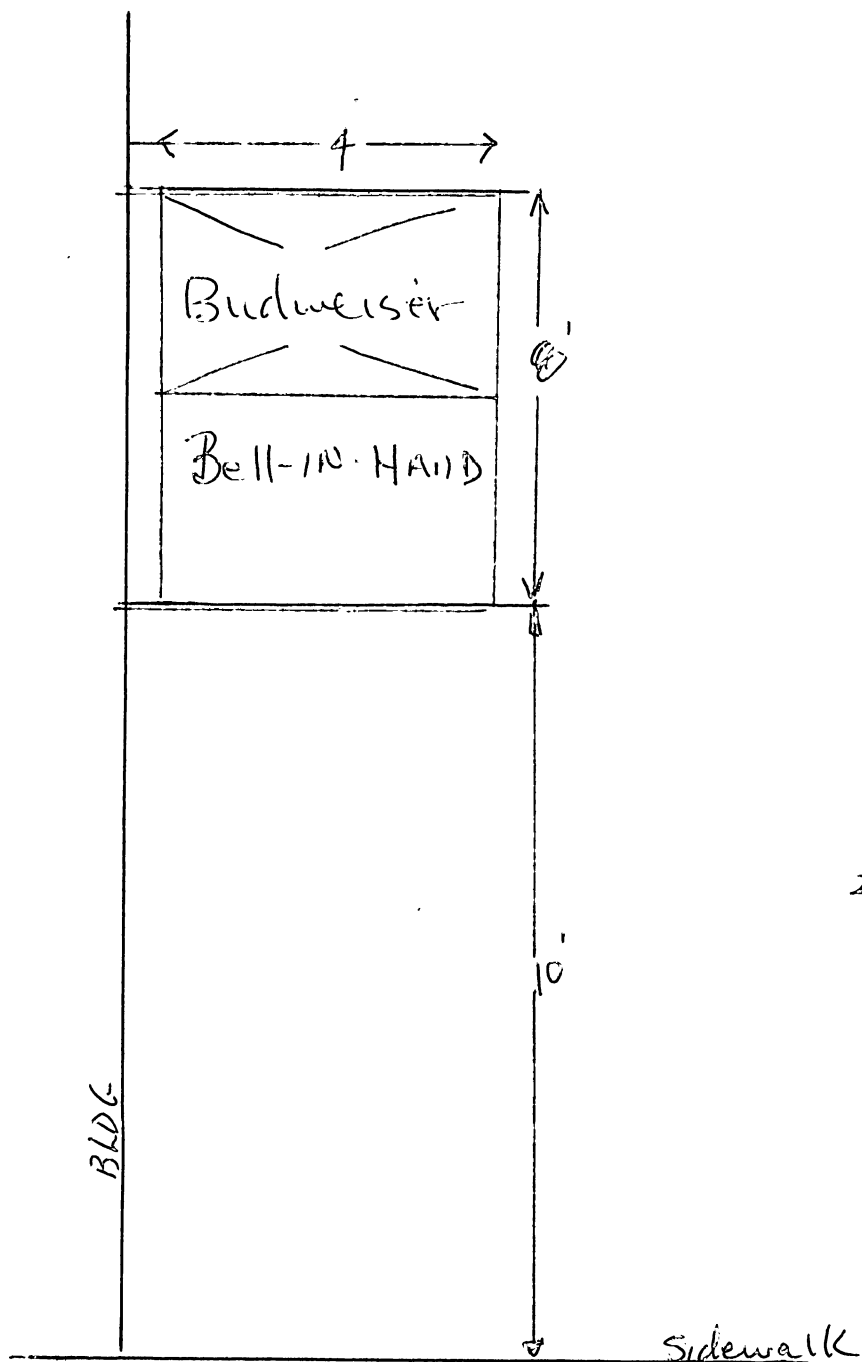

NOTICE . REGULATIONS

SEC. 3608. BUILDING CODE. . PROJECTING SIGNS

1. A projecting sign shall be constructed wholly of incombustible materials, with a metal frame and supports; shall not project out from the wall of a building or other structure a horizontal distance of more than 6 feet; and shall be secured in a rigid manner.

2. Any part of such a sign shall not be less than 10 feet, nor more than 45 feet, above the grade beneath the sign.

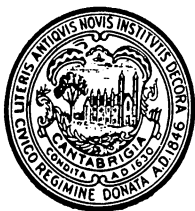

SEC. 3608. BUILDING CODE. . PROJECTING SIGNS
