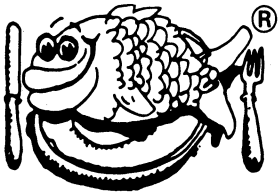

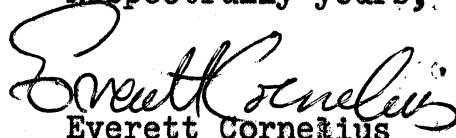
Dear Mr. Russell:

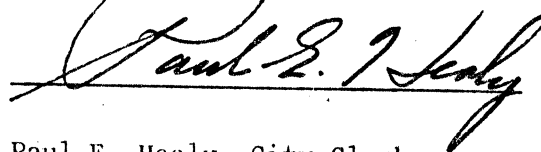

Your letter prior to January 19, 1981 advising the City Council of the contemplated use of the premises will be of great assistance to the City Council in resolving this problem.

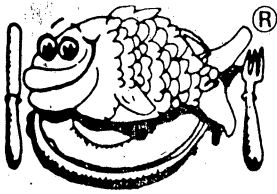

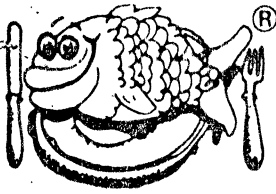

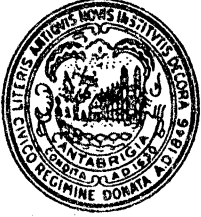
