That the order approved August 18 1894, making a special appropriation of the sum of eleven thousand dollars for the purpose of paving Western Avenue, be and hereby is rescinded, and ^{that} the Superintendent of Streets be authorized to complete the paving of said avenue, on the southerly side, between the railway track and the sidewalk, the expense thereof to be charged by the appropriation for Street Department: Cleaning Streets: Also that the cost of edgestones upon said avenue, heretofore ordered to be charged to the aforesaid special appropriation, be charged to the appropriation for Street Department: Cleaning Streets.
