THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-one

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE SKATING RINK ON GORE STREET IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AS THE REVEREND ROMANO SIMONI SKATING RINK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The skating rink on Gore street in the city of Cambridge shall be designated as the Reverend Romano Simoni skating rink in memory of Reverend Romano Simoni, O.F.M., former pastor of St. Francis of Assisi church in said city. A suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the metropolitan district commission.
