COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: A situation has arisen at the site of the former city dump grounds in which the neighborhood is being affected by the activity taking place with the MBTA dumping in the area; and
- WHEREAS: Filth, foul substance and loose soil is causing an unhealthy environmental impact upon the residents and residences around the land being used as a depository; and
- WHEREAS: Exterminating material has been responsible for the death of pets who have had access to this material in the dump; and
- WHEREAS: There is a need for city employees to be present on this site to protect the interest of the city as well as the interest of the residents and children of this area since the residents of the neighborhood are being inconvenienced in many ways with the activity that will be taking place around there for some time and the city should have some liaison people on the job in order to create as little inconvenience as possible; and
- WHEREAS: Children in their inquisitiveness are attracted to the area and it would be advisable to have a patrol around the site to make certain access and egress is not easily gained by either children or their pets; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to work with the Commissioner of Public Works and the appropriate individual of the MBTA to insure the immediate reassignment of the former work crew at the City Dump so as to prevent any further deaths of animals and more importantly any potential loss of human life; and be it further
- ORDERED: That this crew be instructed to supervise the entrances and egresses of the dump area and to act as liaison between the neighborhood and the city.
