

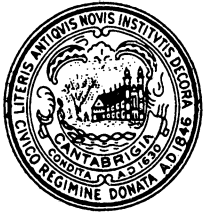

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$200,000 from the Neville Manor Salaries and Wages account to the Neville Manor Other Ordinary Maintenance account.
