Ted Beal was the first state appointed member of the Authority dating back to 1956, and

WHEREAS:

Ted Beal has always demonstrated a high standard of integrity and a sincere interest in public and civic duty, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record extending our sincere appreciation to Thaddeus R. "Ted" Beal for his many years of devotion to this city and its urban problems, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Mr. Beal as a permanent remembrance to him by this City Council.
