Dr. David T. Casey of Winchester, a general practitioner in Arlington for nearly 50 years, died Sunday in St. Agnes' Home in Kirkwood, Mo. He was 84.

Dr. Casey was born in Cambridge. He graduated from Boston College and Tufts Medical School. After completing his residency at Boston City Hospital, he served in the Army Medical Corps during World War II.

Dr. Casey was a former president of the Middlesex South Chapter of the Massachusetts Medical Society.

He leaves two daughters, Elizabeth C. Barnes of St Louis and Mary Kate Culpan of Hillsborough, Calif.; three sons, Michael F. of Winchester, Mark A. of Northampton and James of Virginia Beach, Va.; and nine grandchildren.
