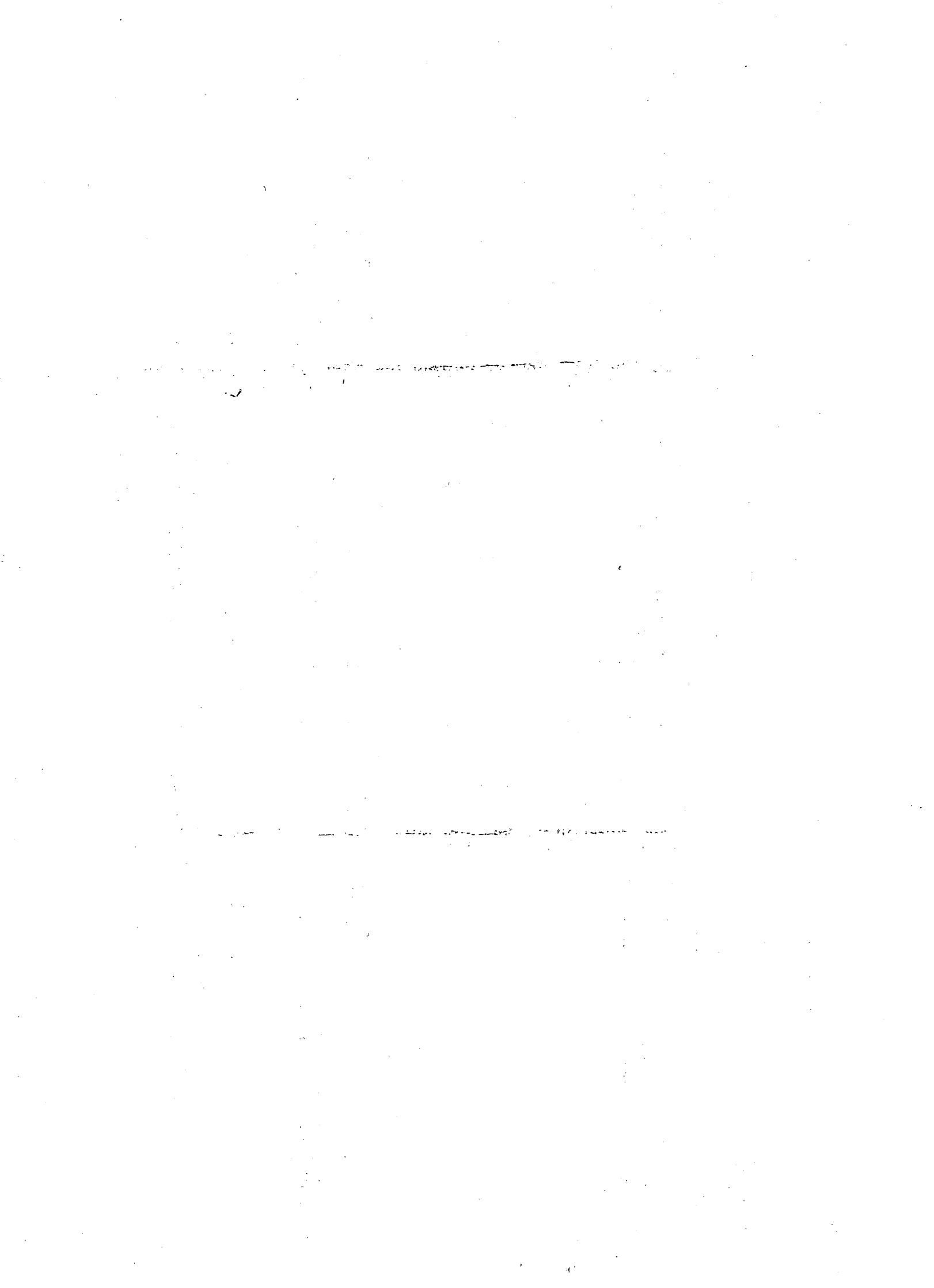

To the Honorable, the City Council:

The Youth Resources Bureau has requested an appropriation transfer in the amount of \$4900, as per attached order.


This transfer will enable the YRB to purchase a van for the transportation of students and equipment in connection with the National Youth Program Using Mini-bikes (NYPUM). As you know, this program serves youths from all neighborhoods in Cambridge who are enrolled in and attending school.

We have found that students using public transportation to travel to the mini-bike track at Sherman Street after school each day lose valuable program time. This has had an adverse effect on the whole NYPUM program. In addition, the high cost of renting vehicles for program activities cut unnecessarily into the program's funds last fall. We want to prevent this from happening again this spring and in the future.

The YRB has informed me that sufficient surpluses exist in their Salaries and Wages appropriation because several staff vacancies have occurred unexpectedly this year. In addition, Public Works Commissioner Fagone has agreed to provide maintenance and other necessary support required for the operation of the van.

Therefore, I am recommending passage of this order.
