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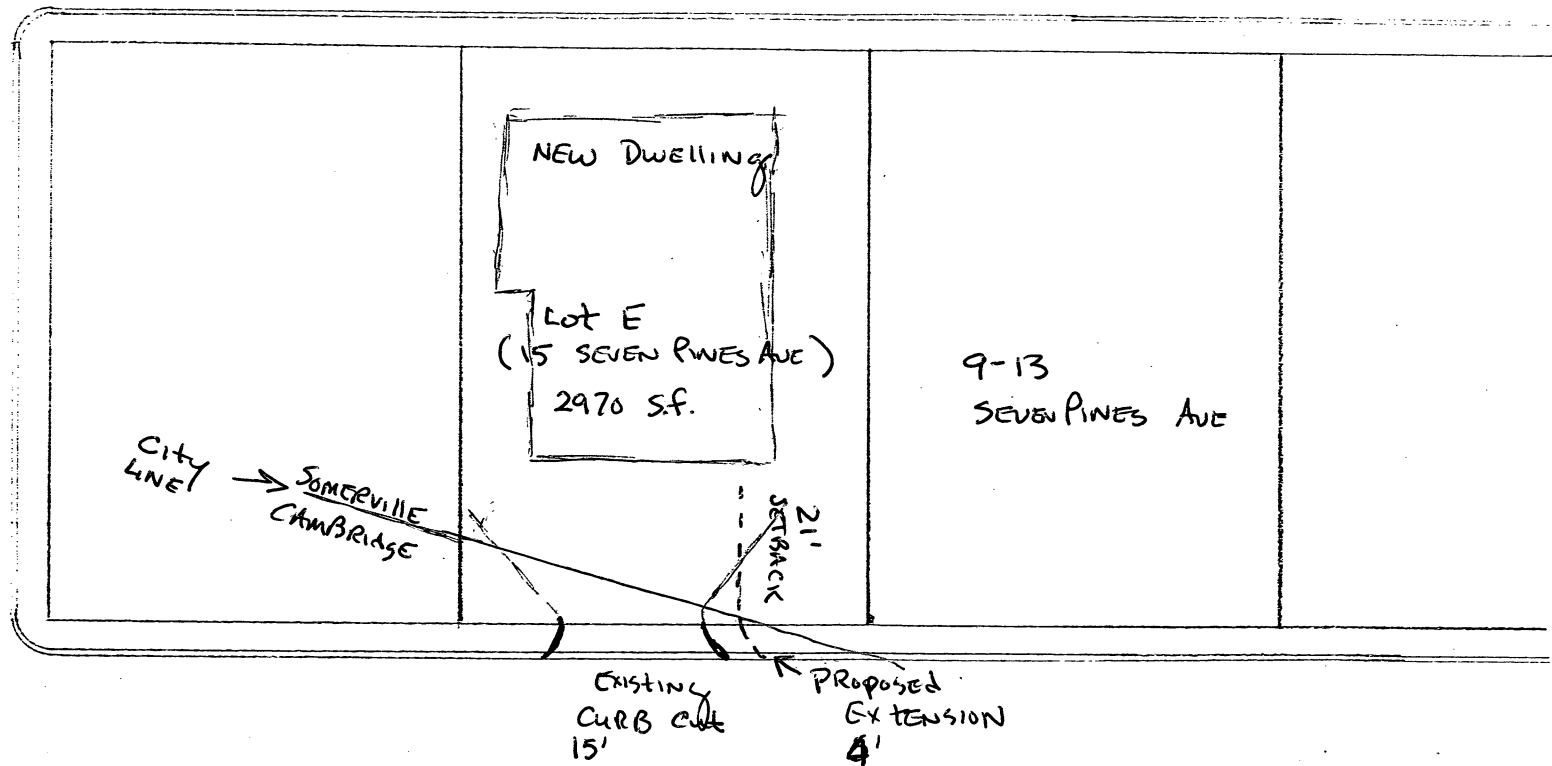
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PROPOSED EXTENSION of EXISTING CURB CUT

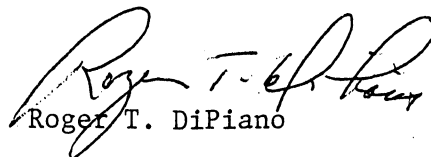

Councillors:

We are writing in regard to Roger T. DiPiano's petition for a wider driveway at 15 Seven Pines Avenue (City Council correspondence item 5 on tonight's agenda).

Neither the petitioner nor the city has notified us--the immediate abutters--or other nearby neighbors about the proposed change in this curb cut, which is situated at an intersection where there are already serious parking and traffic problems. Altering the present configuration of the curb cut may eliminate a parking space from the street, and might involve removing or relocating a city-owned street sign. Moreover, enlarging the driveway might complicate existing problems: parked cars on the street block the driveways, and eighteen-wheel tractor trailer trucks regularly travel on the sidewalk and sideswipe parked vehicles.

We respectfully request that the Council delay action on Mr. DiPiano's petition until the neighbors have been fully informed of his intentions and the concerns of all interested parties have been solicited and given due consideration.

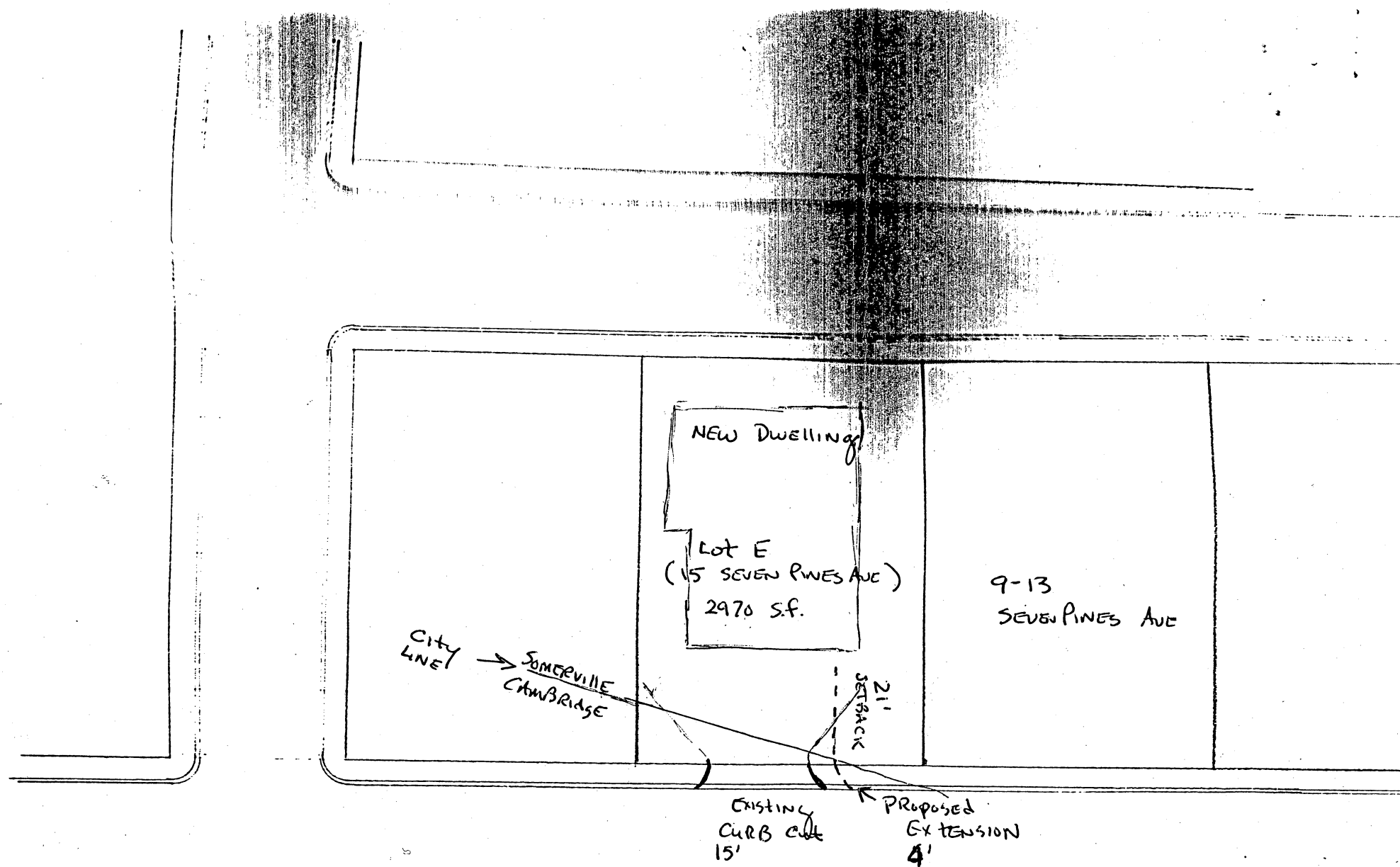
