To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$5,600.00 in the General Fund from the Election Commission (Annual Census) Salary & Wages Account to the Election Commission (Annual Census) Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The funds will be used to cover the cost of mailing a second round of census forms instead of conducting telephone canvassing. The first round of census forms were mailed on December 31, 1992, and in less than 4 weeks there has been a 49% response, way ahead of last year's 46% after 6 weeks.
