

CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

That the City of Cambridge petition the General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to enact the following special Legislation relating to the City of Cambridge and the establishment of fees:

AN ACT RELATED TO THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AND
THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES BY THE CITY COUNCIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. The provisions of the first sentence of the second paragraph of section 53C of chapter 44 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 773 of the acts of 1973, commencing with the words "and the city, town or district" and ending with the word "section", and of the second sentence of the second paragraph of section 53C, shall, on the effective date of this act, not apply to the City of Cambridge.

Section 2. All fees established pursuant to said section 53C of Chapter 44 prior to the effective date of this act shall be and hereby are rescinded.
