To The Honorable, The City Council:

Due to the inordinate amount and complexity of litigation and legal processes during this fiscal year, I am requesting that the City Council appropriate \$250,000.00 to the Law Department Other Ordinary Expenditure, Professional and Technical Services. The source of funding recommended is \$125,000.00 from the Parking Fund to cover the expenses associated with transportation related matters, the SIP revision, Parking Inventory and Scheme Z efforts, and \$125,000.00 from Free Cash to conclude outstanding Civil Rights cases.

Passage is recommended.
