- WHEREAS: Graffiti seems to have appeared on surrounding buildings and properties, which has incurred the wrath of abutting property owners and residents and defacing and destruction taking place by adults who come from outside the neighborhood; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be requested to clean-up-fix-up-paint-up-spruce-up the Warren Pals tot-lot which was created by me as Councillor and named in memory of scores of local Warren Pals war heroes who gave their lives for the love of their country in the "big war" of World War II; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That work on the Warren Pals tot-lot be completed before Memorial Day and that the City Manager report back to the City Council as fast as possible and with the view of appropriating money and assembling the various responsible City agencies into a "massive and lightening" effort to complete the job in order to restore dignity and respectability to the City of Cambridge recreation facility.
